About the Webinar: In the wake of the Texas Supreme Court’s February 2015 decision on the scope of “additional insured” coverage in the *Deepwater Horizon* case, courts may in some circumstances look to extrinsic documents to identify limitations on coverage for “additional insureds.” This presentation will address both the Fifth Circuit’s recent decision applying *Deepwater Horizon* in *Ironshore Specialty v. Aspen Underwriting* and the insurance requirements found in master service agreements in the aftermath of these cases.
